Suggested Literacy activities for 4th Class Group

- How many words can you see in the word 'excellent'? Write them out in your copy!
- **Memory Game: . The Concentration Game:** Get a deck of card and lay out all 52 cards in four rows of 13 (you can include the jokers in six rows of nine cards each, if you prefer). Players take turns choosing two cards, placing them face up. If they are of the same suit and colour (for example, six of diamonds and six of hearts) that player wins the pair and plays again. If the cards are not of the same suit and colour, the player has to return the cards to the board face down and play passes to the player on the left. The game ends when a player picks the last pair. The winner is the person with the most pairs.
