

6TH CLASS PLAN Week beginning 8th February 2021

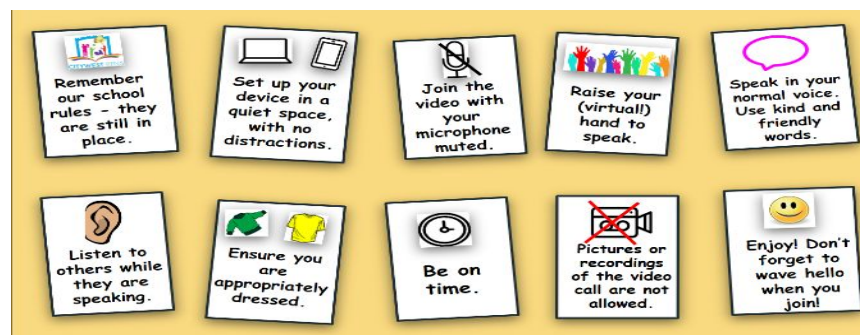



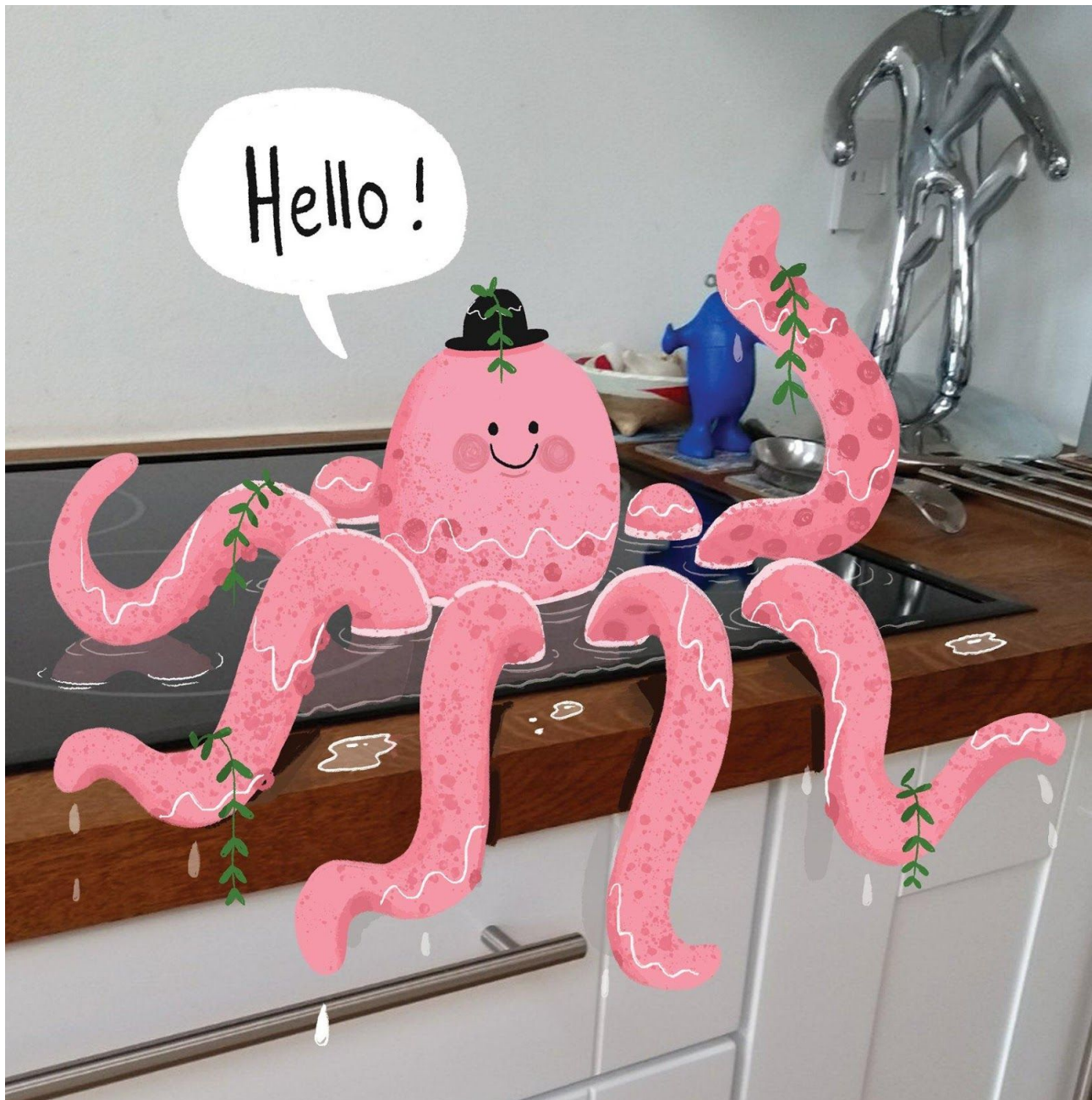

Limerick Rules

Limericks are five lines long
Rhymes on lines 1, 2, and 5
Another rhyme on lines 3 and 4
Rhythm is “da DUM da”
Lines 3 and 4 are shorter

KEY WORDS

THE COMMISSIONING OF THE APOSTLES

After Jesus rose from the dead, he appeared to the eleven apostles and commissioned them to go out among the people and preach the Word of God. (Judas was dead at that time.)

Jesus Appears to his Disciples (Matthew 28:16-18)

The eleven disciples went to the hill in Galilee where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshipped him, even though some of them doubted. Jesus drew near and said to them, 'I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. Go, then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples: baptise them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you. And I will be with you always, to the end of the age.'

- What did Jesus ask the apostles to do?
- In whose name did Jesus ask the apostles to baptise people?

had returned to his Father in heaven. They brought God's love into people's lives and made a difference.

In the following passage from the Acts of the Apostles 4:32-35 we read about life among the apostles and other early disciples of Jesus who were living as Jesus had asked them to.

The group of believers was one in mind and heart. None of them said that any of their belongings were their own, but they all shared with one another everything they had. With great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and God poured rich blessings on them all. There was no one in the group who was in need. Those who owned fields or houses would sell them, bring the money received from the sale, and turn it over to the apostles; and the money was distributed according to the needs of the people.

- What does it mean to be 'one in mind and heart'?
- To 'give witness' means to give evidence that something happened. The apostles gave witness to the fact that Jesus had risen from the dead. How do you think people might have reacted when they first heard that news?
- How does the picture of life among the believers that is depicted in this passage compare with the lives of Christians today? Do you know any Christians who live in a similar way today?

PRECEPTS OF THE CHURCH

The **Precepts of the Church** require members of the Catholic Church to:

- Attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation.
- Confess their sins at least once a year.
- Receive Holy Communion at least during the Easter season.
- Help to provide for the needs of the Church.
- Observe the days of fasting and abstinence identified by the Church.
