



Science	Lever and fulcrum.	Lever and Fulcrum A lever is a simple machine that makes work easier for us. It involves moving a load around a balance point (fulcrum) by using a force. Many of our basic tools, such as scissors, pilers, hammers, nutcrackers and tongs, use levers. When you sit on one end of a seesaw, the other side goes up. This is the basic idea of a lever. When you push or pull the other part in the opposite direction. This is another one of Newton's laws. Investigate: What is a Fulcrum? You will need: Ruler, pocket dictionary Method: 1. Place the ruler on your desk, with part of it hanging over the edge. 2. Place the pocket dictionary on the part of the ruler that is on your desk. 3. Lift the dictionary by pressing down on the part of the ruler that is hanging out. Is it easier to lift the book by pressing on the very end of the ruler or the part that is nearer to the edge of the table? The ruler in this case is a lever and the edge of the table is the fulcrum. The book that must be lifted is called the load.		Yes

Originality

Your work should be original and unaided. Please do not copy another person's work. Any source imagery must be indicated at time of entry. Failure to properly reference any source imagery may result in disqualification.

Number of Entries

You may submit up to two entries per individual but each entry must have its own completed Application Form securely attached to it. Only individual entries will be accepted and they may be submitted directly by you, by your school or by your art group.

Information Required
