<p><u>Monday</u> <u>27th</u></p>	<p>Gross Motor Skills: Complete Episode 5 10@10.</p> <p>Go for a walk or a cycle.</p> <p>Fine Motor Skills: Using some old magazines/lidl brochures/toy catalogues and make a collage by cutting and pasting pictures under the theme of food, toys or animals.</p> <p>Expressive Language:</p> <p>Name all the foods in the kitchen cupboard that are in packets.</p> <p>Name all the foods that are in jars and packets in the fridge.</p> <p>Name all the things you can see in your sitting room and garden.</p>	<p>https://rtejr.rte.ie</p>
<p><u>Tuesday</u> <u>28th</u></p>	<p>Gross Motor Skills: Complete Episode 6 10@10.</p> <p>Play throwing and catching games with a ball. Throw and catch to 10. Throw and catch with a partner. Beat the score. Throw clap and catch. Play donkey. Bounce and catch. Dribble the ball around objects.</p> <p>Fine Motor Skills: Make an item of your choice out of Lego. E.g. a castle, a house, a boat, a rocket.</p> <p>Expressive Language: Ask your child to answer these questions using full sentences. Where did you go?</p> <p>6)I went yesterday.....When did you go?</p> <p>Listen to the story of Farmer Duck by Martin Waddell.
