Monday 27th

Rhyming revision: Read the story Zac the rat and complete the -an and -at activities. Read the story Peg the hen and complete the -en and -et activities on [www.starfall.com/h/index.php](http://www.starfall.com/h/index.php)

Click on grades 123 and go to Learn to Read.

Write a list of -an -at -en and -et rhyming words on a page and draw pictures to go with them.

Tuesday 28th

Play the dinosaurs eggs high frequency words game on [www.ictgames.com](http://www.ictgames.com) choose words in group 5 and 6 of the high frequency words section at the start of the game.

Play the Help a Hedgehog game Phase 2 cvc words and phase 3 ch, sh, th and ng words on [www.ictgames.com](http://www.ictgames.com)

Writing: Write 6/7 sentences about Spring or The farm and read the story aloud for your family.

Wednesday 29th

Reading: [www.oxfordowl.co.uk](http://www.oxfordowl.co.uk) Parents register for free. Choose the book No Tricks Gran from The Oxford Reading Tree. Talk about the pictures. Listen to the story being read. Read the story. Answer comprehension questions based on the story.

Monday 27<sup>th</sup>

Using a hundred square: Count to 100. Count in 2's to 100. Count in 5's to 100. Count in 10's to 100. Count back in 10's from 100.

Choose 6 different numbers on the hundred square. Ask your child to identify the number before it/after it/ above it and below it.

Ask your child some simple addition word problem sums e.g. I had 4 apples and I went to Tesco and bought 5 more. How many apples did I have altogether?

Ask your child simple take away sums to 20 on the hundred square e.g.  $7-3=$   $16-8=$  and write them on a page.

Play the +2 +3 and +4 addition balloon pop games on [www.theschoolhub.ie/sample.php](http://www.theschoolhub.ie/sample.php)

Using a deck of cards: Play a game of snap.

Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup>

Using a hundred square: Count to 100. Count in 2's to 100. Count in 5's to 100. Count in 10's to 100. Count back in 10's from 100.

Choose 6 different numbers on the hundred square. Ask your child to identify the number before it/after it/ above it and below it.

Ask your child some simple addition word problem sums e.g. I had 6 oranges and I went to Super Valu and bought 6 more. How many oranges did I have altogether?

Ask your child simple take away sums to 20 on the hundred square.

Tell the time: Using the clock that you made. Show and tell the time in half hours e.g. half past 7, half past 9.

Ask your child simple take away sums to 20 on the hundred square and write the answers on a page.

Maths Trail: Call out the questions one at a time for your child. Your child finds the answer to each question and writes all the answers on a page numbered 1-10.

1) Count all the windows in the house. 2) Count all the doors in the house. 3) Count all the steps on the stairs. 4) Count all the flowers in the garden. 5) Count all the trees/bushes in the garden. 6) What shape is the tv? 7) What shape is the clock in the house? 8) What shape is the mirror in the house? 9) What number is on your house? 10) What is today's date on the Calendar?
