Valentina Tereshkova

Valentina Tereshkova is a famous Russian **engineer** and **cosmonaut**. She is best known for being the first woman to fly in space.

Valentina's Early Life

Valentina was born on 6th March 1937 in the country that is now called Russia but was then called the USSR. She grew up in a poor family but she dreamt of a life of adventure. Valentina left school at just 16 and worked in a factory but she never gave up on her dreams.

Valentina joined a skydiving club in her spare time and soon learnt that she was a natural. In 1959, Valentina made her first skydiving jump.

The Space Race

At this time, the USSR were in a race against the United States to be the first country to send a woman into space. Valentina applied to be in a space programme and was chosen because of her skydiving skills.

Five women were picked to be trained to be cosmonauts but only one of them would be selected to go to space. Valentina was determined that it would be her and worked extremely hard to secure a place. The training was very difficult, involving weightless tests in zero-gravity and long periods of time alone. The women had to keep their training a secret – even from their own families. After many difficult exams, only two of the women passed the programme and one of them was Valentina. Finally, Valentina achieved her goal and was chosen to go into space alone.

Adventures in Space

One month later, on 16th June 1963, Valentina was launched into space on a shuttle called Vostok VI. This made her the first woman ever in space. She **orbited** the Earth 48 times setting a new world record. She also took incredible photographs in space that helped scientists understand Earth much better.

After three days in space, she returned to Earth but her journey home nearly ended in disaster! There were problems with the ship's programming meaning it nearly crashed. Feeling **nauseous** and dizzy, Valentina managed to correct the problem before passing out. Her training had come in handy and she survived with only a few bruises on her face. She proved that women could react every bit as well as men to the challenges of **spaceflight**.

After her flight, Valentina became an engineer and then a doctor. She has worked with the cosmonaut programme to help to train many more cosmonauts. She now works for world peace and her new goal is to go to Mars.




