Monday 11th

Go to www.twinkl.ie/offer and enter the code IRLTWINKLHELPS to join for free. Play a dice game of roll and read the magic a-e words on www.twinkl.ie/search?term=magic+a+e+words+roll+and+read+activity

Print off the page Magic e a-e words roll and read activity. If you roll a 1 read any of the words on that row and cover with a counter/piece of paper. Do the same for each of the other rows. The game ends when you have covered all the words in any of the rows.

- 2) Sheep+dog Draw a sheep + draw a dog=Draw a sheepdog
- 3) Hair+brush Draw hair+ draw a brush= Draw a hairbrush
- 4) Foot+ path Draw a foot + draw a path= Draw a footpath
- 5) Snow+man Draw some snow+ draw a man= Draw a snowman
- 6) Ear+ring Draw an ear + draw a ring = Draw an earring

Work out the following doubles sums on a page. $1+1=$ $2+2=$ $3+3=$ $4+4=$ $5+5=$ $6+6=$ $7+7=$ $8+8=$ $9+9=$ $10+10=$

On a page:

Draw 2 footballs and colour half of them. (1)

Draw 4 ladybirds and colour half of them. (2)

Draw 6 circles and colour half of them. (3)

Draw 8 flowers and colour half of them. (4)

Draw 10 cupcakes and colour half of them. (5)

Using a hundred square: Count to 100. Count in 2's to 100. Count in 5's to 100. Count in 10's to 100. Count back in 10's from 100.

Using a deck of cards 2-10: Take out all the aces, kings, queens, jacks and jokers you won't need these for the game. You will need 2 players for this game.

Split the cards into 2 equal bundles. You have one bundle and your child has the other bundle. Take the first card off the top of the bundles each time. Look at the values of the cards. Whoever has the lower number gets to keep it each time. Whoever has the most cards when the bundles run out wins.

Thursday 14th

Using a hundred square: Count to 100. Count in 2's to 100. Count in 5's to 100. Count in 10's to 100. Count back in 10's from 100.

Play the +8 +9 and +10 addition balloon pop games on www.theschoolhub.ie/sample.php

Capacity: Ask your child to look at the following and answer the questions.

- 1) Which holds the most liquid the fabric softener or the washing up liquid?
- 2) Which holds the most a cup or a jug?
- 3) Which holds the most a bottle of ketchup or a bottle of vinegar?
- 4) Which holds the least a litre bottle of water or the kettle?
- 5) Which holds the least the carton of orange/apple/cranberry juice or a carton of capri sun?
- 6) Which holds the least an eggcup or a mug?

Make some patterns: You will need 4 blocks of lego for this. 1 red, 1 green, 1 blue and 1 yellow. Stack the 4 lego blocks in different ways to make patterns and draw each one and colour e.g. Red, blue, green, yellow. Red, green, yellow, blue. Green, red, blue, yellow. Yellow, green, red, blue. Blue, green, yellow, red. Yellow, red, green blue. Keep going and see how many different ways you can stack the blocks.

Draw out the blocks on a page and colour after each pattern you make.
