Monday 18th

Magic e: Read the story Robot and Mr Mole and play the 2 Magic o-e games beside story 9 on www.starfall.com/h/index.php

Click on grades 123 and go to Learn to read.

Write a sentence for each of the following Magic o-e words.

- 1)nose
- 2)bone
- 3)robe
- 4)mole

Go to www.twinkl.ie/offer and enter the code IRLTWINKLHELPS to join for free. Play a dice game of roll and read the magic o-e words on www.twinkl.ie/resource/magic-e-with-o-e-words-roll-and-read-activity-us-e-368

Print off the page Magic e o-e words roll and read activity. If you roll a 1 read any of the words on that row and cover with a counter/piece of paper. Do the same for each of the other rows. The game ends when you have covered all the words in any of the rows.

Monday 18th May

Using a hundred square: Count to 100. Count in 2's to 100. Count in 5's to 100. Count in 10's to 100. Count back in 10's from 100.

Using a Calendar for 2020 that you have at home: Look at May 2020 together and ask your child the following questions.

- 1) How many Mondays are in May? (4)
- 2) How many Tuesdays are in May? (4)
- 3) How many Wednesdays are in May? (4)
- 4) How many Thursdays are in May? (4)
- 5) How many Fridays are in May? (5)
- 6) How many Saturdays are in May? (5)
- 7) How many Sundays are in May? (5)
- 8) How many days altogether are in the month of May? (31)
- 9) On what day is the 20th of May? (Wednesday)
- 10) On what day is the 28th of May? (Thursday)
- 11) On what day is the 19th of May? (Tuesday)
- 12) What is today's date? (18th)

Tuesday 19th

Using a hundred square: Count to 100. Count in 2's to 100. Count in 5's to 100. Count in 10's to 100. Count back in 10's from 100.

Using a Calendar for 2020 that you have at home: Look at May 2020 together and ask your child the following questions.

- 1) What day is the 31st of May? (Sunday)
- 2) What day is the 23rd of May? (Saturday)
- 3) What day is the 1st of May? (Friday)
- 4) What date comes after the 7th of May? (8th)
- 5) What date comes after the 2nd of May? (3rd)
- 6) What date comes before the 5th of May? (4th)
- 7) What date comes after the 6th of May? (7th)
- 8) How many days in a week? (7)
- 9) How many days in 2 weeks? ($7+7=14$)
- 10) What date will it be tomorrow? (20th)

Wednesday 20th

Using a hundred square: Count to 100. Count in 2's to 100. Count in 5's to 100. Count in 10's to 100. Count back in 10's from 100.

Play the run to the answer game: Write the numbers 1-10 on the ground using chalk. Leave some space between each number. Or Write the numbers 1-10 on large pieces of paper and spread them out on the ground. Call out the following sums and your child will work them out and run to the answer.

- 1) $3+3$
- 2) $3+2$
- 3) $9+1$
- 4) $6+2$
- 5) $7+2$

- 6) $5+1$
- 7) $8+2$
- 8) $5+3$
- 9) $6+3$
- 10) $5+5$
- 11) $3+4$
- 12) $2+5$

Add in some word problems for your child to solve and run to the answer. E.g. I had 6 lollipops and my friend gave me 4 lollipops. How many lollipops did I have altogether?

- 6) What 3-D shape are your cushions?
- 7) What 3-D shape are your jigsaw boxes?
- 8) What 3-D shape is your fridge?
- 9) What is your favourite 3-D shape?
- 10) Name the 3-D shapes that roll and the 3-D shapes that don't roll.

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
