

Suggested Phonics Activities from Ms. Turtle

Week beginning 18th May 2020

<u>Monday</u> <u>18th</u>	<p>Revise sounds z, w, ng, v, long oo and short oo sing the songs and do the actions. Name items with each sound/digraph.</p> <p>Play tic tac toe with the sounds. Your child closes her eyes and you Say the rhyme: Tic tac toe here we go where I stop no one knows.</p> <p>Point to a different sound/tricky word each time before your child opens her eyes and your child says the sound/tricky word you are pointing to.</p> <p>Revise tricky words 1-5. Put them into sentences. Make the words out of playdough I, the, he, she and me.</p> <p>Play tic tac toe with the words.</p>
<u>Tuesday</u> <u>19th</u>	<p>Revise the sounds y, x, ch, sh, th and th sing the songs and do the actions. Name items beginning with the sounds or which have the digraphs in them.</p> <p>Play the show me... game with sounds y, x, ch, sh and both th.</p> <p>Play the memory game take away 1/2/3 which words are missing?</p> <p>Practice writing tricky words 1-5.</p>
<u>Wednesday</u> <u>20th</u>	<p>Revise sounds y, x, ch, sh and both th songs and actions.</p> <p>Find items beginning with the sound or with the digraphs around the house/garden.</p> <p>Play The Memory game : Which sound is missing 1/2/3?</p> <p>Play The Magic box game: Put the pieces of paper with the sounds y, x, ch, sh and th on them in a box. Pick a sound say it and do the action.</p> <p>Practice writing the sounds y, x, ch, sh and th.</p> <p>Put the tricky words into sentences I, the, he, she, me , we, was, be, to, do.</p> <p>Run to the word game: Write the tricky words I, the, he, she and me in chalk on the ground leaving a space between each word or write each word on large pieces of paper and spread them out on the ground. Call out a word and your child runs to the correct word. This game can also be played with the sounds and tricky words 6-10 by writing them out.</p>
<u>Thursday</u> <u>21st</u>	<p>Sounds hunt- hide the sounds around the house/garden give your child a sound to find each time y, x, ch, sh and th.</p> <p>Sounds pass the parcel game: Write the sounds on the pieces of paper in an envelope and play some music. When the music stops whoever has the envelope picks out the sound and keeps it if they know it.</p> <p>Practice writing tricky words 1-10 I, the, he, she, me, we, was, be, to, do</p>
