

Suggested Literacy Activities from Ms. Turtle

Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup>

Revise the sounds qu, ou, oi, ue, er and ar sing the songs and do the actions. Name items which have the digraphs in them.

Play tic tac toe with the sounds. Your child closes her eyes and you Say the rhyme:

Tic tac toe here we go where I stop no one knows.

Point to a different sound each time before your child opens her eyes and your child says the sound you are pointing to.

Revise tricky words 1-10. Put them into sentences. Write the words I, the, he, she and me, we was, be, to, do.

Play tic tac toe with the words.

Play Tricky word bingo 1-10. Make 2 bingo cards of 6 squares each and choose 6 tricky words each. Call out a different tricky word each time. The first to have all the words on their card wins.

Thursday 4<sup>th</sup>

Revise sounds s, a, t, i, p, n and c, k, e, h, r, m, d sing the songs and do the actions.

Name things around the house beginning with each of the sounds.

Play Bingo with the sounds. Make 2 bingo cards of 8 squares each. One for you and one for your child. Ask your child to choose 8 of the letters and you choose 8. Call out a different sound each time. Cross out each one. The person who gets all the sounds first wins.

## Friday 5<sup>th</sup>

Revise sounds s, a, t, i, p, n and c, k, e, h, r, m, d sing the songs and do the actions.

Name things around the house beginning with each of the sounds.

Revise the tricky words 11-15 are, all, you, your, come. Put them into sentences.

Play tic tac toe with the words.

Practice writing tricky words 11-15.
